- 19. Which is the highest educational qualification that Ramanujan held apart from his FRS?

- 20. Your Hit Parade was a famous American show in the 1950s and 1960s. How is it related to Ramanujan?
- 21. Which book is stated to be the first to have greatly influenced Ramanujan's approach to mathematics?
- 22. According to Ramanujan, he often received inspiration for his mathematical discoveries from visions of this Hindu Goddess. What was her name?
- 23. In August 1905, Ramanujan ran away from home, and stayed in this city for nearly a month. Which city was this?
- 24. Ramanujan was the second Indian to be elected as Fellow of the Royal Society (in 1918), UK.
  Who was the first? In which year was he elected?
- 25. How does the Government of India celebrate Ramanujan's contributions to mathematics?
- 26. The unbelievable story that Ramanujan failed in a mathematics exam does the rounds often. How far is this true?
- 27. Why did many members of his family boycott his funeral?
- 28. What was the exact cause of his untimely death?
- 29. How is the name Nagoya related to Ramanujan's life?
- 30. How did Ramanujan get his name?
- 31. We hear so much of Ramanujan's mentor at Cambridge Univ. G.H. Hardy. What was his full name?
- 32. Which came first to Ramanujan? Fellowship of the Royal Society, or the Fellowship of Trinity College?
- 33. This "gang of four" contributed to Ramanujan's memory. What is their names?
- 34. Ramanujan was once compared to Beethoven. On what occasion? By whom?
- 35. What was Hardy's reaction when he saw the notebook Ramanujan sent him?
  - (Note: This became the beginning of an incredible intellectual relationship between two giants belonging to two different cultures).

36. Finally, the question which many people find most difficult to answer: Specifically, for which mathematical contributions was Ramanujan elected to the Royal Society?
