Abstract

This document¹ shows how to use frameboxes for titles. It also shows how to draw lines/rules of varying lengths and thicknesses and position them.

1 Frame box

A framebox is a box with a frame around it. You can position the framebox anywhere on the page. You can position the text in the framebox, anywhere you want.

Box is on the Right side of the page.

1.1 Fbox side-by-side

Use tabular environment and multicolumn for side-by-side framebox and framebox stacked on other frameboxes. This is a tricky operation. Use frugally.

2 HRules

Different lengths, different positions, different thicknesses



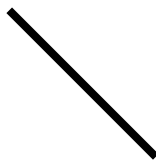
Adjust the position using a dummy (zero length) rule.

A tilted rule !

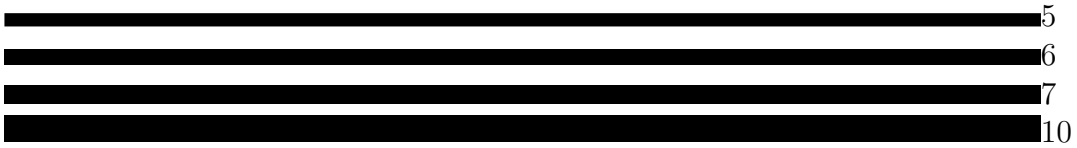


A quick brown fox jumped over the little lazy dog.
